## WHAT IS ORPHAN GRAIN TRAIN?

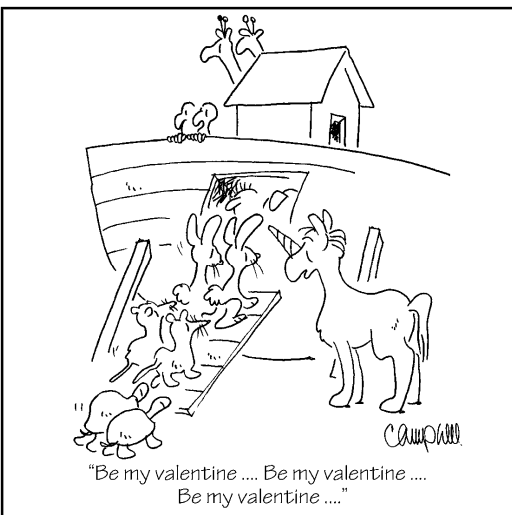
Orphan Grain Train is a Christian volunteer network that shares personal and material resources with needy people in America and around the world.
