SCHOOL WILL BEGIN on August 23 for the 111th year at 8:15 AM

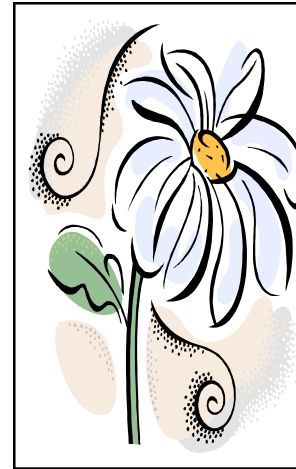
