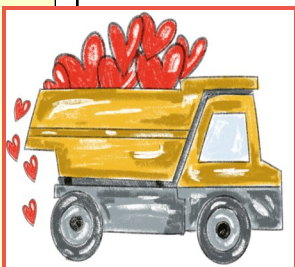

### HOW DO I CHECK MY LUNCH ACCOUNT BALANCE?

This is found in fastdirect. It looks different depending on if use a computer or your phone:

- If you check fastdirect through the app on your phone: Click on the "\$ Finance & Online Payments" tab. You'll be taken to the finance page. Click on "Transaction History". There you will see a box that says "Account balances for (insert your name)" One of the options under that is "Lunch". Your account balance is listed under "Lunch". If you click on that dollar amount, it will show you daily charges for lunch.
- If you check fastdirect on your computer: Click on the "\$ Finance" tab at the top of the screen in the blue strip. You'll be taken to the finance page. There you will see a box that says "Account balances for (insert your name)" One of the options under that is "Lunch". Your account balance is listed under "Lunch". If you click on that dollar amount, it will show you daily charges for lunch.

### HOW DO I LET THE SCHOOL KNOW OF ANY CHANGES TO MY CHILD'S SCHEDULE OR NORMAL ROUTINE (i.e. not in school, picked up early, leaving for an appointment)?

**If there is a change during the school day for how your child will get home** (i.e. they were to ride the bus, but you are now picking them up.), please contact Amy in the office by fastdirect, texting/calling 507-329-7464, or calling 507-662-5860. Amy will then let the teacher know. The teacher may be too busy to check their phones for messages. We don't want a message to be missed and for your child to either be on the bus by mistake or waiting for you when they should have been on the bus.

**However, if you know of a change in advance** (not during school hours on the day of), you can just let your child's teacher know. Amy only needs to know if it's a change from when you sent your child off to school that morning.

# Immanuel Lutheran School FINE ARTS FESTIVAL 2025

## *“Showcasing Your Strengths”*

**March 6th, 2026 here at Immanuel**

**(March 7th at MLHS Northrop for an additional experience and judging opportunity)**

- Judging at Immanuel *during* the school day-
  - open to parents and students who participate in the event
- **Public performance** in the sanctuary that evening--
  - The “Fine ARTS Showcase” (6:30 p.m.) will include the display of all ILS students’ art projects
  - as well as individual and small group instrumental, vocal, and public speaking performances from earlier in the day

\*\*\*\*\*

- **ART PROJECT: ALL STUDENTS in K-8th submit an art project** for both the March 6th and March 7th events (*chosen by the student & teacher at school*).

In All Performance AREAS and Art Projects:

- ♦ K-2nd projects receive participation ribbons
- ♦ The 3rd-8th grade projects are judged and eligible to receive blue, red, and white ribbons indicating a Superior, Excellent, or Good rating

- **CREATIVE WRITING:** Optional for 1st-8th grade students- Poems, stories, personal narratives (allowing artwork for expression) - Give to classroom teachers by February 27th.

- **PERFORMANCE ARTS CATEGORIES:** Optional for students in K-8th:

**DRAMATIC READING** Examples include the reading of a poem, a persuasive speech, team reading, short skit, comedy sketch-***must present a copy of the reading to the judge***- eye contact, proper volume, annunciation, voice inflection and delivery will be emphasized (2-5 minutes)

*NOTE: Dramatic reading choices will be pre-screened by Mrs. Mattila by February 20th to ensure proper content and to offer insights toward optimum performance.*

**VOCAL** Solo, duet, trio, small group vocal performance-***must provide a numbered measure copy of the music for the judge*** (3 minute max)

*NOTE: Vocalists should plan to pre-screen song choice with Mrs. Soleta to ensure proper song selection for voice range.*

**INSTRUMENTAL** Solo, duet, trio, small group instrumental performance-***must provide a numbered measure copy of the music for the judge*** (3 minute max)
