The church and school are in need of raising funds for the projects that are currently going on. The school is replacing furnaces and windows in the gym and some classrooms. The total needed funds to complete these repairs is \$16,000. We have received donations toward this project of \$26,000. The other project currently taking place is the handicap bathroom and lift project for the church. There is \$44,000 of projected cost that has not been covered by past and present donations to the project. If you would like to give towards the cost of completing these projects please consider making a special donation to the capital improvement fund so we can keep the church and school in good condition.
